The seemingly impossible goal, born just a few short years ago, to build a remote sensing network both above and below the water in the heart of the Great Bear is now fully in practice.

Highlights this year include the wild success of [Great Bear LIVE](#), our non-invasive camera project that streams the mysterious wilderness of the Great Bear Rainforest live on the Internet. Further, expansion of the [Great Bear Sea Hydrophone Network](#) has expanded our ability to monitor the behaviour and migration patterns of orca and humpback whales. We hosted the first [Sea & Life Training](#) program as part of the SEAS (Supporting Emerging Aboriginal Stewards) Initiative. Additionally, we continue to support efforts to keep our [oceans wild](#) and [tanker-free](#), protect [bears](#) and [wolves](#) in their habitat and collaborate on unique and creative film projects.
